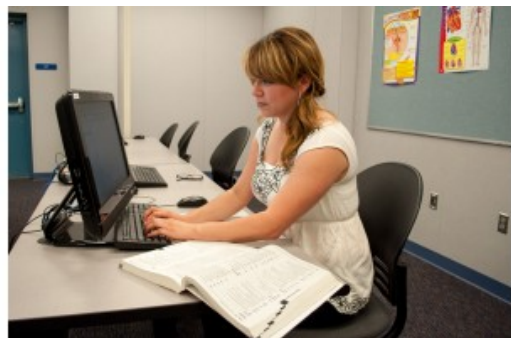


Dental Assisting-Career Preparation

Short Description

This is a one and one-half year Dental Assisting program designed for high school students to prepare them to enter the field of Dental Assisting upon graduating from high school.

Description

Open to 12th grade students. Students must complete Dental Assisting for High School Students with an A or B in the class prior to registering for this course. Students will continue their study of Dental Assisting. In addition, students who are 18 years old will complete the Dental radiology certification program. And when meeting all the state dental radiology safety requirements, they can obtain a Dental Radiation Safety Compliance Certificate. Upon successful completion of this 1 and ½ year program and graduating from high school, students will have the opportunity to complete a 120 hour externship in a dental office in the South Bay. All supplies and materials are provided for this class.

Prerequisites

Prior to Enrolling: Must be a 12th grade high school student Must complete Dental Assisting for High School Students with an A or B Sign a Student Waiver and Release Form
During the Course: If 18 yrs old, student will complete dental radiology certification Prior to externship during the summer, student must complete TB testing and vaccines
