Short Description

Does the sound of sirens make your heart race? Do you have what it takes to keep your cool in an emergency situation?

Description

This introductory course offers students an overview of what it is like to be first on the scene providing efficient and immediate care to ill and/or injured victims and to assist other emergency medical services providers. The emergency response training includes instruction in CPR, First Aid, an overview of the Emergency Medical Services System, anatomy and physiology, triage and post-emergency care duties, legal and ethical issues, communication skills, and stress management.

• Open to high school and adult students • If an adult, provide proof of a HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA or GED (translated into English) • CPR skills will be taught as part of the course.
