Budget Update

Superintendent St. Gean reviewed the revenue projection for 2016-2017 through 2018-2019. Through a combination of funding sources, SoCal ROC will be able to meet its financial obligations. These are considered "soft funding" sources, meaning that they are not guaranteed from year to year. However, Superintendent St. Gean remarked that SoCal ROC needs a dedicated funding solution so that SoCal ROC can continue to provide quality and relevant programs to high school students and adults throughout the South Bay.
